Graduation PROGRAM COMPLETION

Directors who complete the entire CUDA Program (all of the courses in Levels A, B and C) receive a certificate marking their achievement.

Accreditation BECOMING ACCREDITED

Directors who complete the CUDA Program and have served on a credit union board for two years may write a qualifying exam to become an Accredited Canadian Credit Union Director (ACCUD). This accreditation is awarded jointly by Dalhousie University and the Credit Union Institute of Canada (CUIC®).



CONTINUING EDUCATION (CE)

To maintain the ACCUD accreditation, a total of four (4) CE credits must be earned annually by either:

- Completing CE courses outlined in *Cusource*® Director catalogue (2-5 CE credits)
- Attending the CCUA National Conference (4 CE credits)
- Participating in the Director Stream of the National Mentorship Program (2-5 CE credits)
- Joining *Cusource* governance webinars (1 CE credit)
- Completing non-*Cusource* governance training/events (2 CE credits)
